The Fisheries Committee for the West Central Gulf of Guinea (FCWC) is pleased to invite qualified individual consultants to submit proposals for the position of National Consultant in Nature-Based Coastal and Marine Solutions (NBS) in Ghana.

This assignment is being undertaken within the framework of the MarEcoPlan Project, funded by the Global Environment Facility (GEF-7) and implemented in collaboration with the International Union for Conservation of Nature (IUCN). The project supports the sustainable management of coastal and marine ecosystems across the Gulf of Guinea through integrated approaches, including Marine Spatial Planning (MSP), Payment for Ecosystem Services (PES), and Nature-Based Solutions (NBS).

## **Objective of the Assignment**

The objective of this consultancy is to support the international NBS expert in the collection and analysis of national data, coordination with stakeholders, and facilitation of the institutional integration of nature-based coastal and marine solutions in Ghana.

## **Scope of Services**

The selected consultant will be expected to:

- Support the collection, consolidation, and analysis of data related to coastal and marine ecosystems;
- Facilitate engagement with national institutions, local communities, and relevant stakeholders;
- Contribute to the identification of priority areas and opportunities for implementing NBS;
- Assist in organizing national consultations, workshops, and capacity-building activities;
- Provide technical inputs into reports and other key project deliverables.

## **Duration**

The assignment will be conducted over thirty (30) working days, spread across the 2026 project implementation period.

## **Eligibility Criteria**

Interested candidates should meet the following minimum requirements:

- A Master's degree in coastal zone management, environmental science, marine ecology, geography, or a related field;

- At least five (5) years of relevant professional experience in coastal or marine resource management or environmental projects;
- Demonstrated experience in stakeholder engagement and coordination;
- Strong analytical and technical writing skills;
- Good knowledge of Ghana's coastal ecosystems and institutional framework.

#### Submission Requirements

Applicants are required to submit the following documents:

- A detailed Curriculum Vitae (maximum of 5 pages);
- A Technical Proposal outlining the understanding of the assignment, methodology, and work plan;
- A Financial Proposal indicating professional fees only (excluding associated costs).

#### Submission Deadline

Proposals must be submitted no later than 19th May 2026 at 5:00 PM GMT.
